



Information for skiavoriaz.co.uk guests

Welcome to our apartment. We hope you had a good journey and are ready to enjoy the delights of skiing in this region. The following information is to help you make the most of your stay.

Linen

You should have a full linen supply – sheets, duvet covers, towels, bath mats, tea towels. If anything is missing please contact the Maeva reception in Residence Antares. Do not allow them to charge for these (this is the norm with their clients in Antares).

Reception

The reception in Antares is at your disposal. There is usually a reception drinks on Sunday where they go through the services they offer. If you want to know the weather, need extra piste maps, need to know where any of the ski school meeting points are or have anything in the apartment that needs fixing please contact them. Reception opening hours and Sunday drinks timing are posted on the noticeboard in reception.

Getting to the Village Centre

As you leave the door to the Aster Residence turn left and go over the bridge to the door marked Ascenseur Public . At the end of the corridor there is a lift down. Leave the lift and walk across to the door again signed Asenseur Public . Again the lift is at the end of the corridor. At the bottom of the lift you are in the main centre.

Ski Shop

The MirFamose ski shop is directly opposite the lift in the centre. Take one of the cards in our information book and they will offer 25% discount to the public prices. If you have pre-ordered then let someone know as you arrive. If your skis need waxing during the week they will do this free of charge if you hire from them.

Ski Lockers

You should have received keys to the ski locker. The ski locker room is on the ground floor and our locker has the room number 305 on it. If you leave your boots on the spikes overnight they will be warm and dry in the morning. Please keep the locker locked if you are not using it and it is advisable to lock the outer door to the locker room (with the apartment key) when you leave.



Supermarket

The Sherpa supermarket is well stocked and very friendly. Information on the shop is contained in our information book – attention is drawn to their offer of a pierrade (hot stone) or fondue which you can have for the evening if you book in advance and buy the meat from them.

Restaurants

There are a number of restaurants in the village centre. If it is your first evening and you want something close by we recommend L'Igloo. Walk past Mirfamose and L'Igloo is on the right on the floor above the back door to Sherpa. The owners are English and the food is very good. See further recommendations later in this book.

Tourist Office

If you walk past Mir Famose up the hill the tourist office is on the right after the merry go round. Here you can find out what activities during the week are being organised by the resort . At Christmas and New Year the fireworks are a highlight – enjoy a free Vin Chaud in the centre then return to the Apartment for a great view of the fireworks in Avoriaz, Morzine and Les Gets.

Lift Passes

If you have not received your tickets using the highly recommended pre-booking service on the internet then you will need to get your tickets from one of the 2 ticket stations in the village. There is one in the main centre past the Tourist Office and the other is at the Prodains Telepherique Station – which can be skied to on your first morning from the apartment. (see skiing suggestions).

Internet

There is wireless internet in the apartment – the password is in the guest book.
